Dr. Kim Lamberty is the Executive Director of the Quixote Center, an organization focused on promotion of sustainable development, U.S. policy reform, economic justice, and educational initiatives in Haiti and elsewhere. She has been developing and managing faith-based justice, peace, cross-cultural, and community service programs for over 25 years. She has accompanied vulnerable communities and human rights workers in Palestine, Colombia, and the U.S.-Mexico border through her work with Christian Peacemaker Teams, from 2004 to 2008. She managed church-based Haiti programming and directed work with U.S. universities for Catholic Relief Services from 2010 to 2019. She is also founder and president of Just Haiti, a fairtrade coffee company that focuses on economic justice for vulnerable small-scale farmers. Kim specializes in addressing root causes of poverty, violence, and environmental degradation, especially relating to economic justice and Haiti, and has published numerous articles on the topic. She holds a Master's in International Affairs from Columbia University and a Doctor of Ministry degree, in cross-cultural ministry, from Catholic Theological Union.
